1. Organizing Authority

The organizing authority is the Sarasota Sailing Squadron.

2. Rules

This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the ISCA Class Rules.

3. Eligibility

The regatta is open to all US Sunfish Class and International Sunfish Class Members who are women.

4. Registration & Fees

4.1 Registration is \$80 per boat. All registrations received after Sept. 12th, 2010 will be charged a \$15 late fee. Registration fee includes entertainment and snacks Friday night, dinner Saturday night, 1 t-shirt, lunch Saturday, complimentary beer and water and pizza after the race Sunday.

9.1 One race constitutes a regatta.

9.2 When fewer than 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

10. Prizes

Awards will be given out according to the number of registrants and to the first junior and first master.
