



1ST SUNFISH YOUTH WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP

The Organizing Authority is the International Sunfish Class Association
Sayville Yacht Club
Blue Point, NY 11715
July 15-18 2010

1. Rules: The regatta will be governed by the 2009-2012 racing rules of sailing and the rules of the International Sunfish Class Association, except as any of these altered by the Sailing Instructions.

2. Advertising: Advertising will be restricted to Category A.

3. Eligibility and Entry: Each competitor shall be a current year (2010) member of their respective country's Sunfish Class Association. Sailors must not reach their 19th birthday during the 2010 calendar year.

3.1 Number of Sailors: The regatta will be limited to a maximum of 35 sailors. Participation will be determined as follows: 3 from each non-U.S. NSCA's, 5 from USSCA, and 2 additional from USSCA as the host country and 1 additional from the host club. Non-U.S. entries will be on a first come, first serve basis. NSCA's wishing to send additional competitors may apply for a waiting list by sending the registration and charter fees. Those registrations will remain on hold until June 1st. Any open spots after June 1st will be filled from the waiting list, taking 1 competitor from each NSCA at a time, by registration date, until all spots are filled. The remaining sailors from the waiting list will be fully refunded (No administration fee will be charged). Sailors will be notified of their eligibility by June 7th. If all slots are not filled by June 1st, the remaining slots shall be filled by sailors submitting the proper registration and fees on a first come, first serve basis.

3.2 Non-U.S. NSCA Qualification: Each NSCA will determine it's own country's qualification system.

3.3 U.S. Qualification: Sailors qualifying for the United States must submit a resumé that shows evidence of participation, over the two year period prior to the event, in the following categories: At least 25% their yacht club's Sunfish races, two Sunfish regattas held anywhere in the U.S. and at least one Sunfish world qualifier event. If the sailor's yacht club does not offer Sunfish racing, they may petition to have this requirement waived. However, for 2010, if a sailor cannot meet all of these requirements, they may petition the Sunfish Junior Coordinator to accept them for entry into the regatta. All resúmes must be submitted to the Junior Coordinator by May 15th at which time they will be reviewed. Sailors will be notified of their eligibility by May 20th. Weighted consideration will be given to those sailors who have participated in national and regional events as well as their finishing positions in those events. If all US slots are not filled by May 20th, the remaining slots shall be filled by sailors submitting the proper resumé, registration and fees on a first come, first serve basis.

3.4 Advance Registration: Competitors may register on-line or by completing the entry form and sending it with the appropriate fees to ISCA, PO Box 300128, Waterford, MI 48330-0128 USA. Registrations are not considered official until all fees have been received.

3.5 Payment Method: Payment may be made by credit card or by check in US dollars payable to "ISCA" drawn on a US Bank.

3.5.1 Checks: If checks are used, the damage deposit must be sent with a separate check. The amount, whether credit or check, will not be cashed (paid) until the regatta and only in the event of damage.

3.5.2 Proof of Payment Date: In case of paying by check or wire transfer, a scanned copy of the check or the wire transfer receipt must be sent by email or fax to the ISCA office to confirm the payment date. For Non-US participants, checks must be sent to ISCA by FedEx, DHL or UPS (Regular mail is not recommended). The ISCA office will confirm the payment date when the original document is received and the date is compared with the one stamped by the mailing institution. If the document does not arrive within 10 days, the Class Office will ignore the copy of the check and use the real date of reception.

3.5.3 Other Payment Methods: Countries where there are no means to send wire transfers, credit cards or checks, will be allowed to reserve spots by sending a letter. However, the funds shall be received, by any means, by one ISCA Officer by the registration deadline or the spots will be released. Such kind of registrations will require the approval of the ISCA President and the ISCA Treasurer.

4. Fees: There will be a 100 USD fee per competitor. This includes 2 continental breakfasts, 2 lunches and two dinners.

4.1 Charter Fees: Charter Boats will be available, addition information will follow.

4.2 Refunds of Fees: Entry and charter fees are **NON-REFUNDABLE** unless all 35 spots are filled by the date of the regatta. All entry fees to be refunded are subject to a 10% administrative fee.

- 5.1 Number of races:** There will be a maximum of 11 races. One race will constitute a regatta.
- 6. Measurement:** All boats may be measured against the class rules prior to and/or during the regatta.
- 7. Sailing Instructions:** Will be available at the registration desk.
- 8. Venue:** The regatta will be held at the Sayville Yacht Club and the surrounding waters of The Great South Bay
- 9. Courses:** The courses will be either Windward/Leeward, Triangle or a combination thereof.
- 10. Scoring:** Scoring will be low point scoring system in accordance with Appendix A2 of the racing rules except that one throw out will be given after 6 races have been completed.
- 11. Radio Communication:** A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications unavailable to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephone.
- 12. Prizes:** Prizes will be awarded to the top 5 finishers as well as the top midget and the top opposite sex.
- 13. Disclaimer of Liability:** Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.
