There are three types of events governed by the USSCA:

- 1) **Open:** Open to all Sunfish sailors
- 2) **World's Qualifying:** Open to all USSCA members
- 3) **Pre-Qualified:** All participants must have qualified in advance

You must be a Class member to sail in a Regional Championship as well as the US Midwinter Championship, US Master's, Women's N.A.'s and the North American Championships. You can join the Class at these events or by contacting the Class Office: USSCA, PO Box 300128, Waterford, MI 48330-0128. The telephone number is 248/673-2750. **Mandatory Class membership for ALL World Qualifying Events will be enforced.**

Eligibility requirements are as follows:

- Midgets:** A Sunfish sailor may compete as a Midget if they have not reached the age of 14 at the time of the regatta. In Midget Doubles, both skipper and crew shall be Midgets.
- Juniors:** A Sunfish sailor may compete as a Junior if they have not reached the age of 18 at the time of the regatta. In Junior Doubles, both skipper and crew shall be Juniors.
- Masters:** A Sunfish contestant shall qualify to race as a Master if his/her 40th birthday occurred prior to the first race of the regatta.

2005/2006 UNITED STATES SUNFISH CLASS NOTICE

WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFICATION FOR THE UNITED STATES

The following sailors automatically qualify for the 35th Sunfish World Championship from the United States:

The top seven (7) US finishers in the North American Championship, the top finisher in the US Junior North American Championship and the top one (1) or two (2) finishers in each of the Regional Championships held annually shall qualify. (Depending on each region's allotment, one or two sailors qualify annually. Regions allotted two positions may hold two regionals with the top sailor from each qualifying). A total of sixteen (16) sailors will qualify from regional events. The top finisher from the Women's North American Championship, the top finisher from the US Master's Championship and the top four (4) finishers from the US Midwinter Championship shall qualify.

Should a World qualifier be unable to attend, that place will be filled from the alternates list in descending order of finish. No alternate will be chosen from a Regional, Midwinter, Women's or Master Championship if it becomes necessary to go below tenth place. That qualifying position will revert to the North American Championship, except that no qualifying position will be taken if it becomes necessary to go below 30th place.

If a sailor qualifies in two (2) events, the event that took place first shall take precedence.

Sailors may race in any or all Regional Championships and may qualify in any region. This gives Sunfish sailors throughout the U.S. sixteen (16) or more chances to qualify for the World Championship.

All USSCA qualifiers must be members of USSCA in the year they qualify, i.e., all USSCA qualifiers must have been USSCA members in the previous year and must be current members of USSCA to be eligible to race in a World Championship event.

If all USSCA places are not filled, alternates will be selected from an alternates list based on a sailor's finish in a qualifying event. A list of alternates will be made using those sailors finishing in the top ten at a Regional, Midwinter, Womens or Masters championship and not previously receiving a World's bid, and those finishing below 30th in the North Americans weighted by their finish in a qualifying event, (i.e., a third place finisher in a Regional, Womens or Master event will be given a weighting of 3 where a 45th place finisher in the North Americans will be given a weighting of 45). Alternates will be selected from this list in the order determined by their weighting.

If all remaining USSCA places are not filled from the list of alternates, an "at large" wild card drawing may be made. The "at large" list will be made up from qualified sailors not previously receiving an invitation who have submitted their names to the Class Office prior to the wild card drawing.

SUNFISH NORTH AMERICAN CHAMPIONSHIP

All current members of the ISCA are eligible to sail in the Qualification Series of the North American Championship.

All former and current Sunfish World Champions and Sunfish North American Champions are eligible to sail in the Championship Series without having to sail in the Qualification Series at the Sunfish North Americans. Any Champion who elects to sail in the Qualification Series will be counted toward qualifiers. This applies to the senior division only.

Any sailor who is a current member of ISCA may compete in the Sunfish North American Championship.

SUNFISH JUNIOR NORTH AMERICAN CHAMPIONSHIP

The Sunfish Junior North American Championship is sailed concurrently with the Qualification Series at the North American Championship.

All current members of ISCA who will not attain the age of 18 during the regatta may compete. If sailing with a crew, or in a Junior Doubles Championship, both shall be Juniors as defined above. The top five (5) finishers are qualified to compete in the North American Championship.

Organizations seeking to host World Qualifying Events should submit to the USSCA Events Chairman a request by June the year preceding the event. It is the Class' intention to have dates established at least a year ahead of the scheduled date so that other Clubs and Fleets can adjust their schedules and regattas to permit sailors to participate in these events. Please work closely with the USSCA Event Chairman when setting dates for your event.

REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

Any registered USSCA member may compete in any Regional Championship throughout the country. Sailors competing in the Sunfish Regional Championships must be current members of USSCA/ISCA. Proof of membership will be required.

SAIL HONOR AWARDS

Every member shall be entitled to apply to his sail the symbol earned by him racing in a sanctioned event, in accordance with the following schedule:

World Champion - Gold Class Insignia	Regional Champion - Silver Chevron
Continental Champion - Silver Class Insignia	Fleet Champion - Black Chevron
National Champion - Gold Chevron	

All sail awards shall be made by the USSCA. World, Continental, National and Regional awards will be automatically presented to the champions each year.

Fleet Captains must apply in writing to the USSCA for fleet sail awards. The Fleet Captain must provide:

- Fleet Champion's full name, address and registered sail number;
- Number of races in the fleet series (minimum: 5 races);
- Total points obtained by the fleet champion and runner-up in the series;
- Fleet Charter number and location of racing activity.

Team (T), Masters (M), Womens (W) and Junior (J) Champion awards shall include the appropriate letter ("T", "M", "W", "J") in the middle of the insignia or directly under the chevron. Each member(s) of the championship shall be entitled to display a sail award.

Chevrons shall be applied to the sail centered below the sail numbers with the chevron apex up. Additional chevrons shall be located below the first. See Class Rules for placement of chevrons.

HOSTING WORLD QUALIFYING EVENTS

Organizations seeking to host World Qualifying Events should submit to the USSCA Events Chairman a request by June of the year preceding the event. It is the Class' intention to have dates established at least a year prior to the scheduled date so that other Clubs and Fleets can adjust their schedules and regattas to permit sailors to participate in these events. Please work closely with the USSCA Event Chairman when setting dates for your event.

2005/2006 INTERNATIONAL SUNFISH CLASS NOTICE

SUNFISH WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFICATION

Each National Sunfish Class Association shall determine the World Championship Qualification System for their country. In any question over citizenship/residency, the NSCA shall determine who represents their country. A total of thirty (30) sailors are eligible to qualify from the United States. All other countries are allowed to send five (5) sailors plus one additional sailor for every ten members over their basic membership of twenty members up to a maximum of ten sailors. The host country is allowed to send five (5) additional sailors.

Any country not previously recognized by the ISCA may qualify up to two sailors at the World Championship if they can form an NSCA that must have a minimum of five members that have paid their dues to the ISCA by May first of the year of the Championship."

The top ten (10) finishers at the previous World Championship and all former and current World Champions automatically qualify in addition to the quotas for their countries. Also, the top five (5) finishers at the European and South American Championships and the winner of the Masters International Championship are eligible to compete in addition to country quotas. In addition, the North American, South American, and European Champions for the prior three (3) years also qualify for the World Championship. Alternates will not be selected to fill these places should the qualifier be unable to attend.

All World qualifiers must be current members of ISCA to be eligible to race in the World Championship.

In addition, all ISCA Advisory and World Council members and committee chairpersons qualify for the World Championship: All NSCA representatives to the Advisory and World Councils including the current and immediate past ISCA president, the vice president, secretary, treasurer, the chief measurer, membership committee chairperson and the advisory council chairperson. Attendance at the World Championship by the above is critical for the coordination of the ISCA. The above qualifiers shall be over and above the quotas for all NSCA's. Should one of the above be unable to attend, no substitute World Qualifier shall be allowed.

BOAT DISTRIBUTION

In the event that there are an insufficient number of World boats available for the number of World competitors qualified above, a round robin series where boats are shared will be sailed. After the first two days of racing, the fleet will be split into gold and silver fleets.

After the cutoff date for Worlds deposits, any unfilled boat spots shall be filled by a fair choice from a pool of international wild card sailors who have applied through their NSCA of their interest in competing. If there are any available Worlds boats at the event site, the boats may be filled by the host country from their NSCA members who have paid their dues by the cutoff date for Worlds deposits.

SAIL HONOR AWARDS

Every member shall be entitled to apply to his sail the symbol earned by him racing in a sanctioned event, in accordance with the following schedule:

World Champion - Gold Class Insignia

Continental Champion - Silver Class Insignia

National Champion - Gold Chevron

Regional Champion - Silver Chevron

Fleet Champion - Black Chevron

All sail awards shall be made by the sponsoring Sunfish Class Association. World, Continental, National and Regional awards will be automatically presented to the champions each year.

Fleet Captains must apply in writing to their NSCA for fleet sail awards. The Fleet Captain must provide:

- Fleet Champion's full name, address and registered sail number;
- Number of races in the fleet series (minimum: 5 races);
- Total points obtained by the fleet champion and runner-up in the series;
- Fleet Charter number and location of racing activity.

Team awards shall include the letter "T" in the middle of the insignia or directly under the chevron. Each member of the championship team shall be entitled to display a sail award.

Chevrons shall be applied to the sail centered below the sail numbers with the chevron apex up. Additional chevrons shall be located below the first. See Class Rules for placement of chevrons.

2005/2006 INTERNATIONAL SUNFISH CLASS NOTICE

SANCTIONED EVENTS

The following events shall be deemed to be sanctioned events for the purpose of the Constitution, the Rules and the Bylaws of the ISCA:

- World Championship Event;
- Continental Championship events including North American, South American and European Championships, and North American Women's, Juniors and Doubles Championships;
- National Championship events including Mid-Winter and Team National Championships;
- Regional Championship events; and
- Any other events as may be designated by the World Council or NSCA, as the case may be.

Any sanctioned events shall be conducted in accordance with the rules and guidelines as set forth by the ISCA.

ADDITIONAL RULES WHICH APPLY WHILE RACING

- Nothing shall prohibit two persons from racing a Sunfish sailboat provided that both persons sail together for the entire series.
