



## **NORTH JERSEY SUNFISH CHAMPIONSHIPS**

Welcome to the 2011 sailing season. The long winter is behind us. The dates are all set. It is time to start sailing!

The Sailing Association of North Jersey Lakes continues to boast large, competitive and friendly Sunfish fleets. Our fleets typically include both novice and world class sailors. All racers are always welcome. Need a boat for the day? Give us a call. The more the merrier. Join us for some great tight racing on our small and challenging lakes.

### **Championship Series**

The championship series will again consist of four one-day regattas. All sailors will race together in one fleet, with trophies presented in both "Championship" and "Challenger" divisions. No more than 4 races will be sailed on any race day. No throw-outs will be used in determining the daily regatta standings, but 4 throw-outs will be used to calculate a sailor's overall series finish.

To qualify for overall series prizes, sailors must be 2011 members of the USSCA. Sailors may participate in individual regattas without joining the USSCA, but to be scored for the championship, 2011 class membership is required.

The championship will be governed by The

Racing Rules of The ISAF with the prescriptions of US Sailing. The Class Rules of the ISCA will apply.

### **SANJL Youth Regattas**

Youth Sunfish sailing on the lakes in our area is growing fast. Several of our local clubs have thriving youth programs. Many kids are learning to sail with some regularly traveling to regional and national regattas. Over the years we have seen successive generations of young sailors quickly progress from being the new kids at their first regatta into expert racers. The centerpiece of our junior season is the SANJL Youth Championship. This is where the area junior sailors gather, regardless of ability, and enjoy a great day of racing with their peers.

This year SANJL is offering two youth events, an open regatta at HSC on July 30th and our annual Youth Championship Regatta on August 20th at Smoke Rise. A separate flier will detail these regattas. Please help all your local young sailors get to these events. Give them a ride, lend them a boat, teach them a new trick, show an interest.

It will not be long now. We will be sailing before you know it. See you on the water!
